Friday 6th October

Saturday 7th October

- **Various workshops** in Botesdale Village Hall, led by members of the local churches. The workshops are:
 - a willow workshop in which you will be make a dragonfly (Karen Lawrence)
 - a lino cutting and printing workshop on the theme of harvest (Caroline Davidson)
 - making church banners (Barbara Norburn, Sarah Raynham, Jean Wright)
 - an acoustic guitar workshop (Jamie Cleaver)
 - and a "session" about a local brewery! (Mark Duxon)

All of these workshops are **free** and will take place in Botesdale Village Hall.

Times and booking details for these events are as follows:

- willow workshop: four workshops each 45 minutes long running from 10am, 11am, 2pm and 3pm
- lino cutting and printing workshop: two workshops each 2-hours long, 10-12noon and 2-4pm
- church banners workshop, drop in for 2-hours or 5 minutes starting at 10am and 2pm
- acoustic guitar workshop, a 2-hour workshop starting at 10am
- beer talk and tasting, two 45-minute sessions exploring the role of yeast, malt, water and hops in making a craft ale (over 18's only), 10am and 11am

The purposes of these workshops is to have some fun and have a chance to ask some questions about life and where Jesus fits into all of this.
